Cases Diverted (Cumulative)

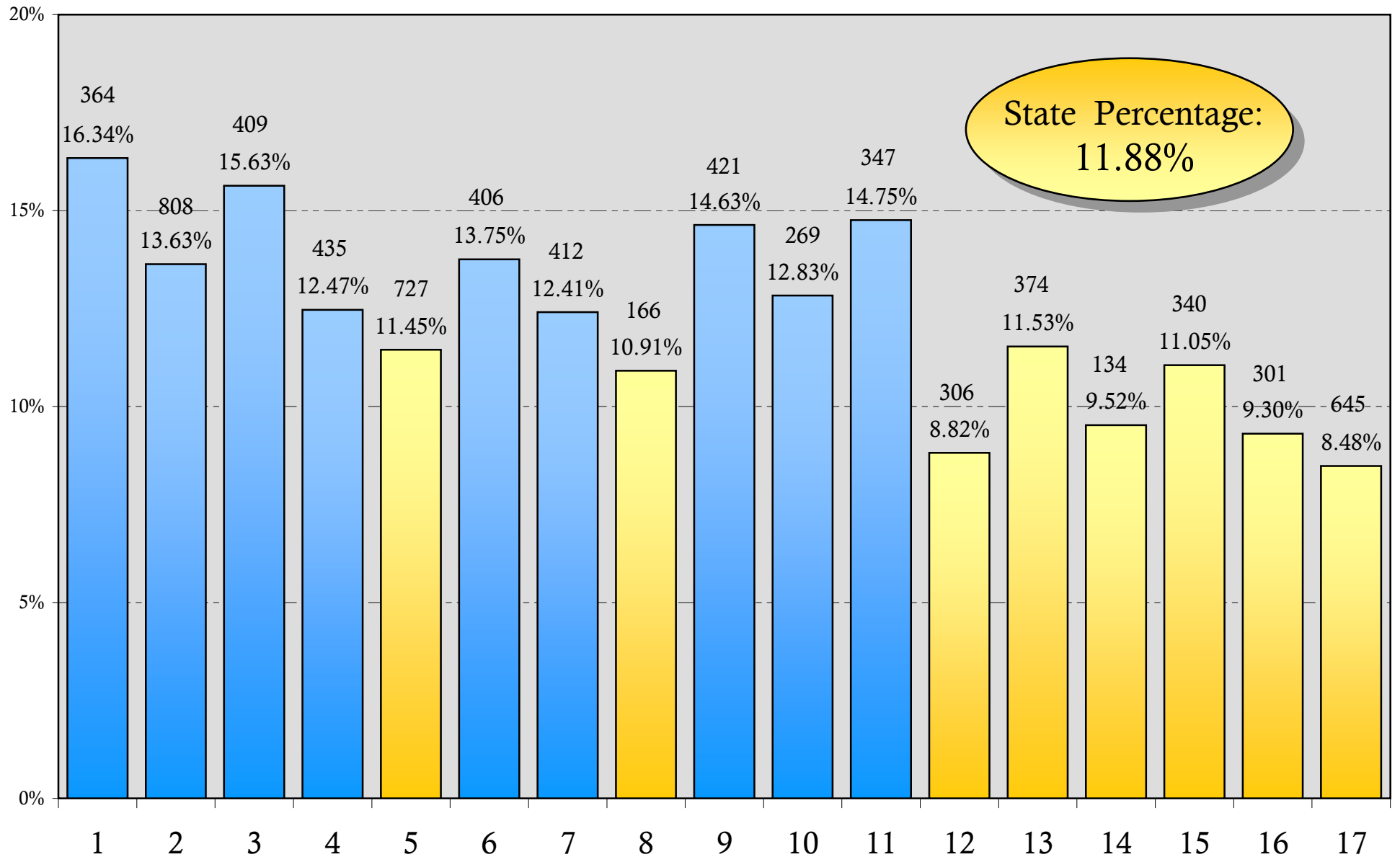

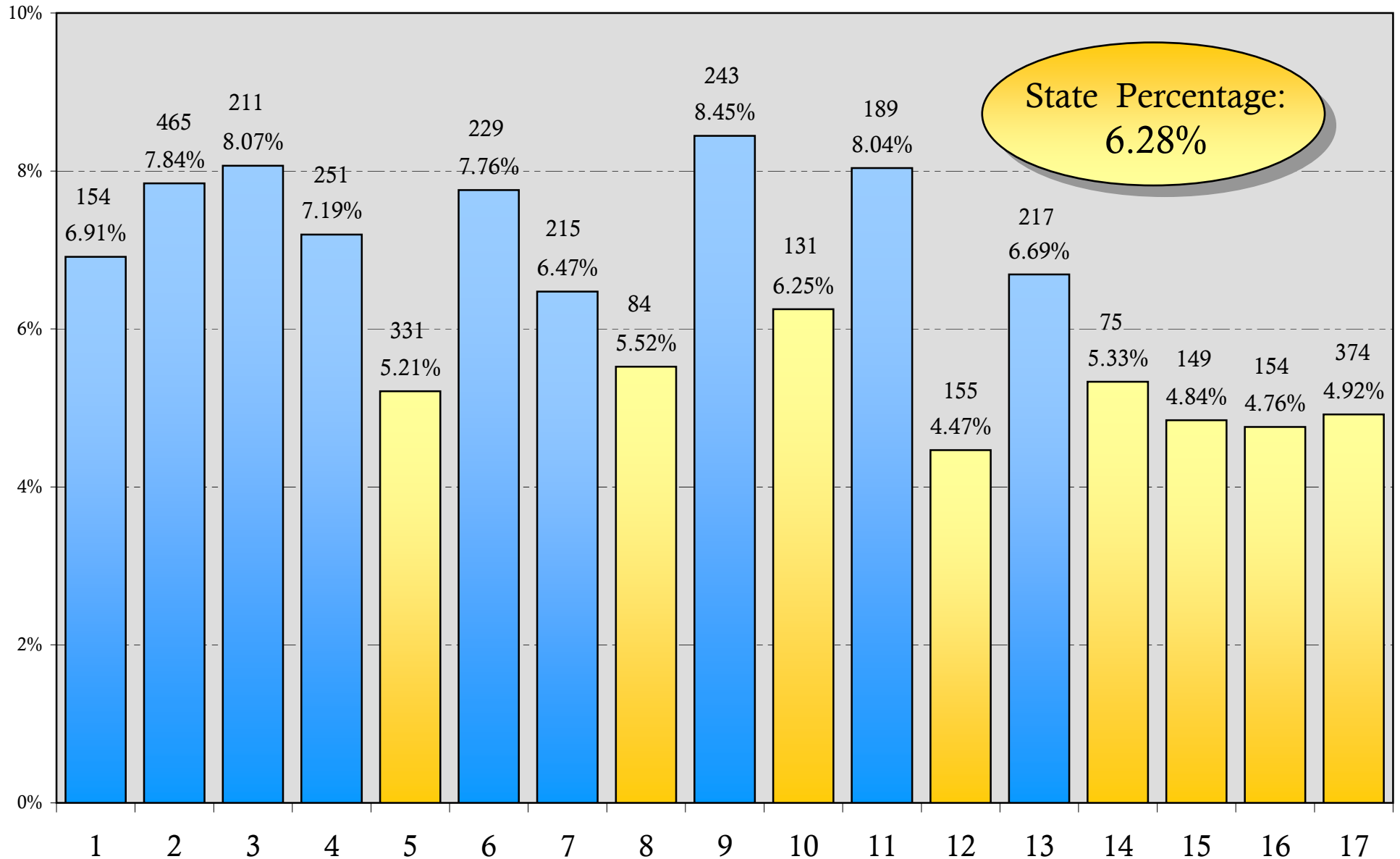
Diversions That Became CPS Cases (Cumulative)

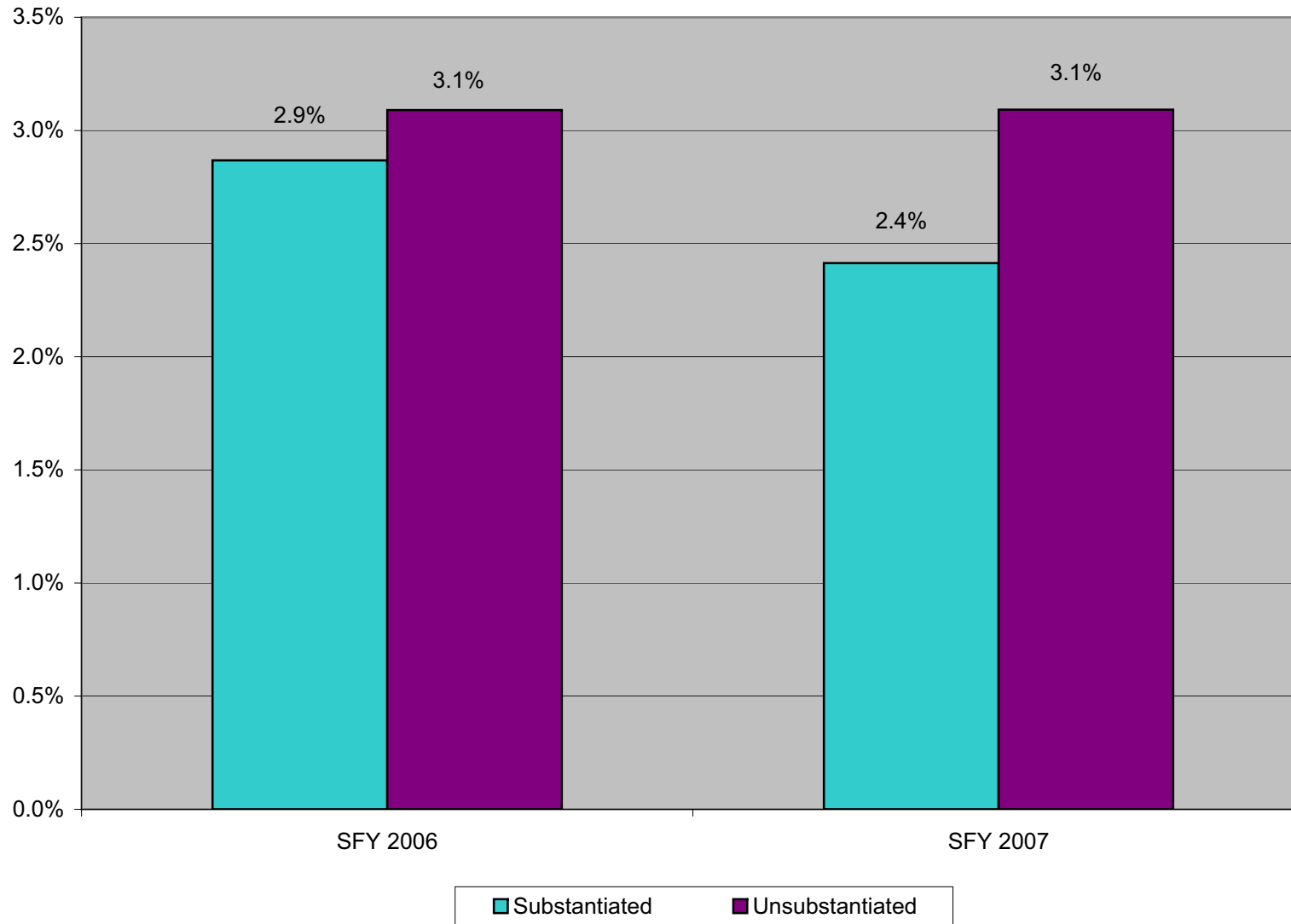

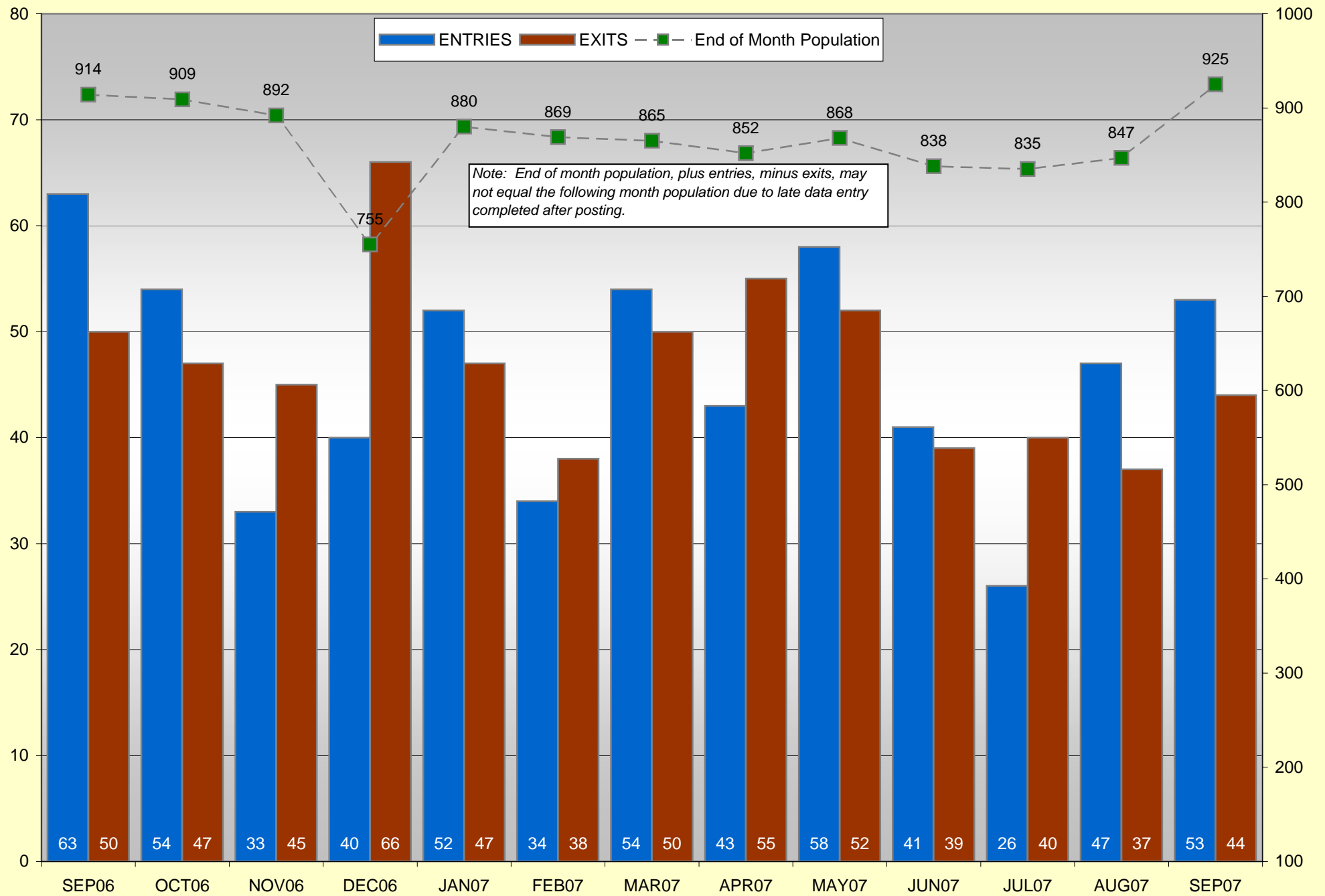


Children Entering and Exiting Placement Statewide (September 2007)



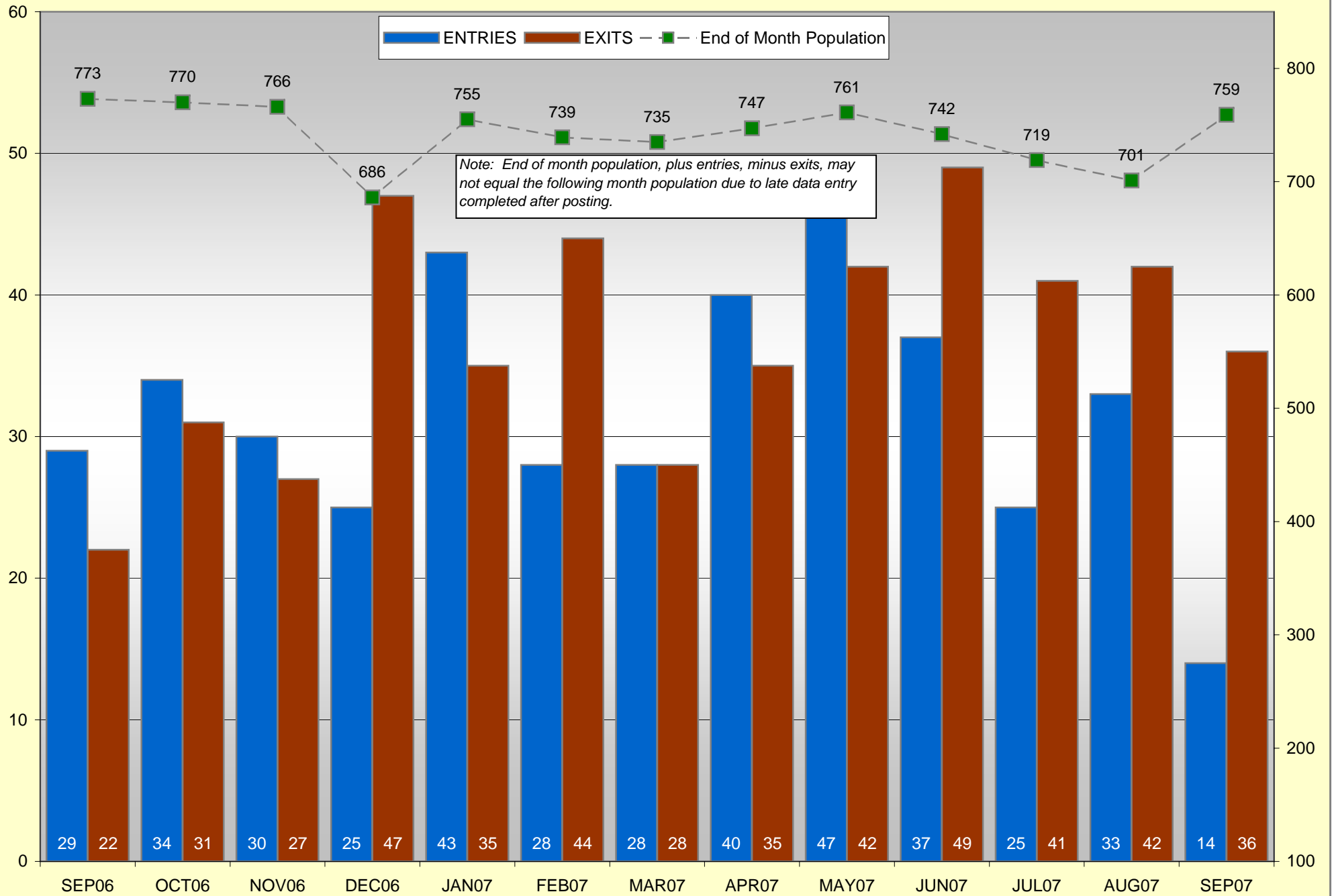

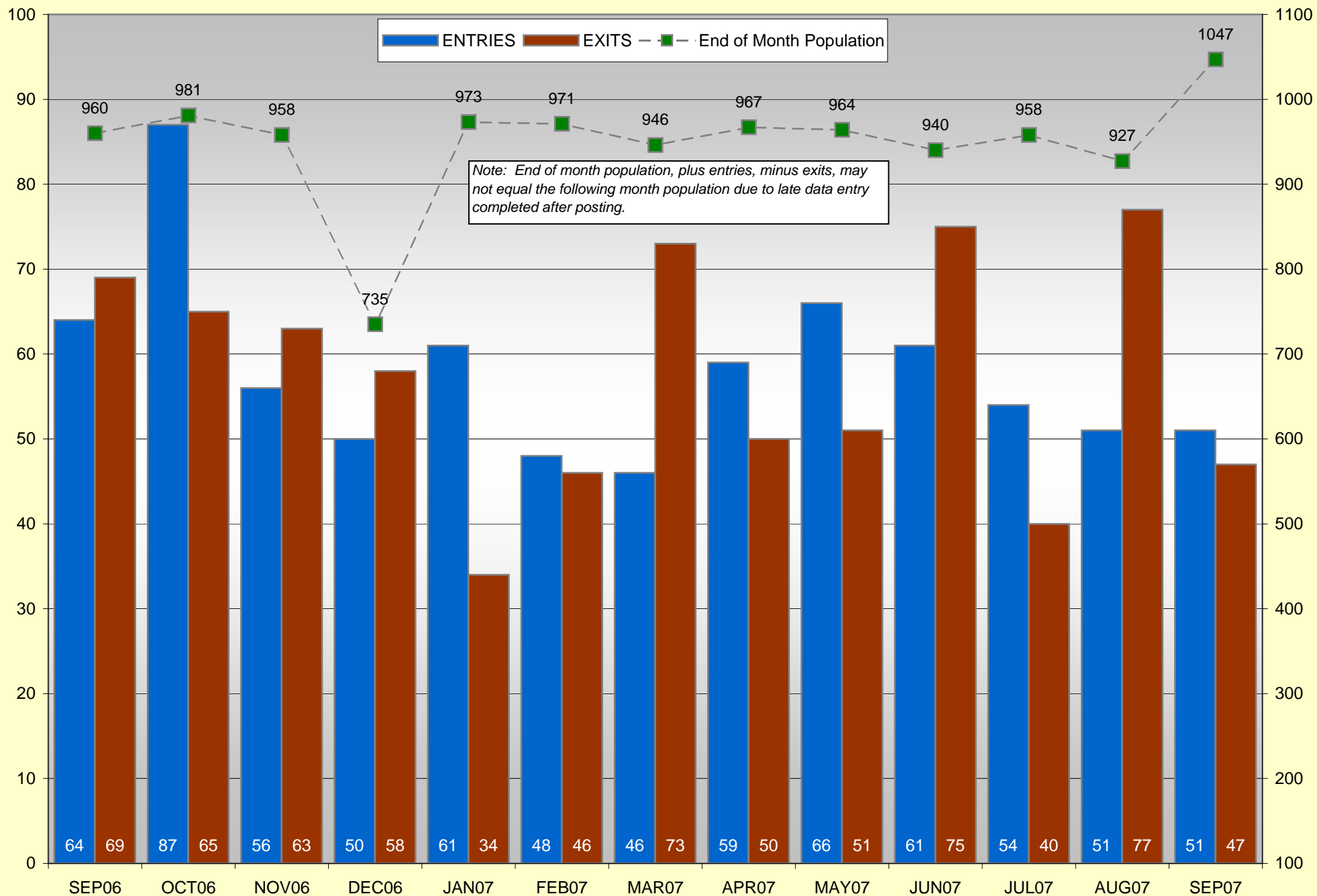
Children Entering and Exiting Placement Fulton County (September 2007)

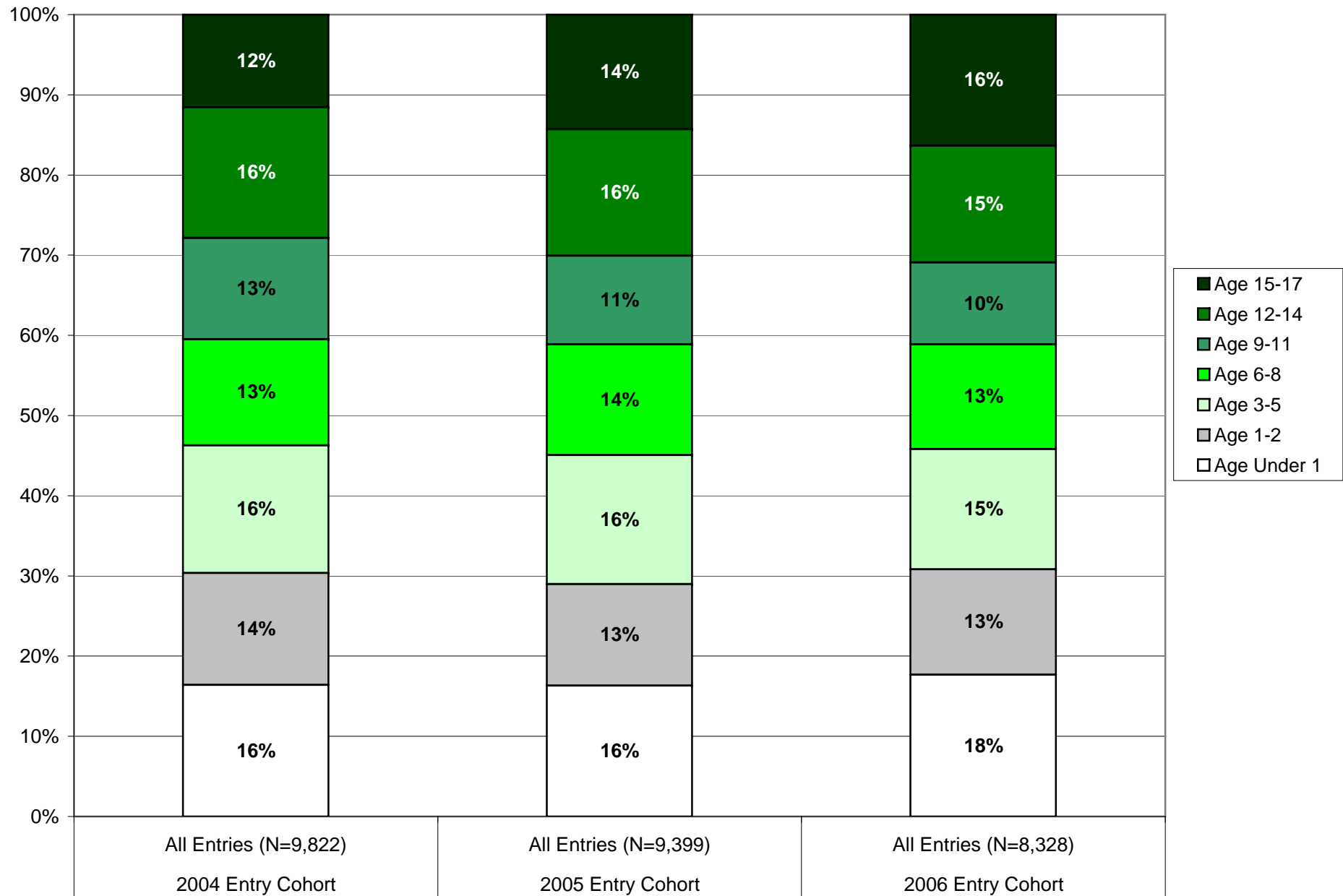

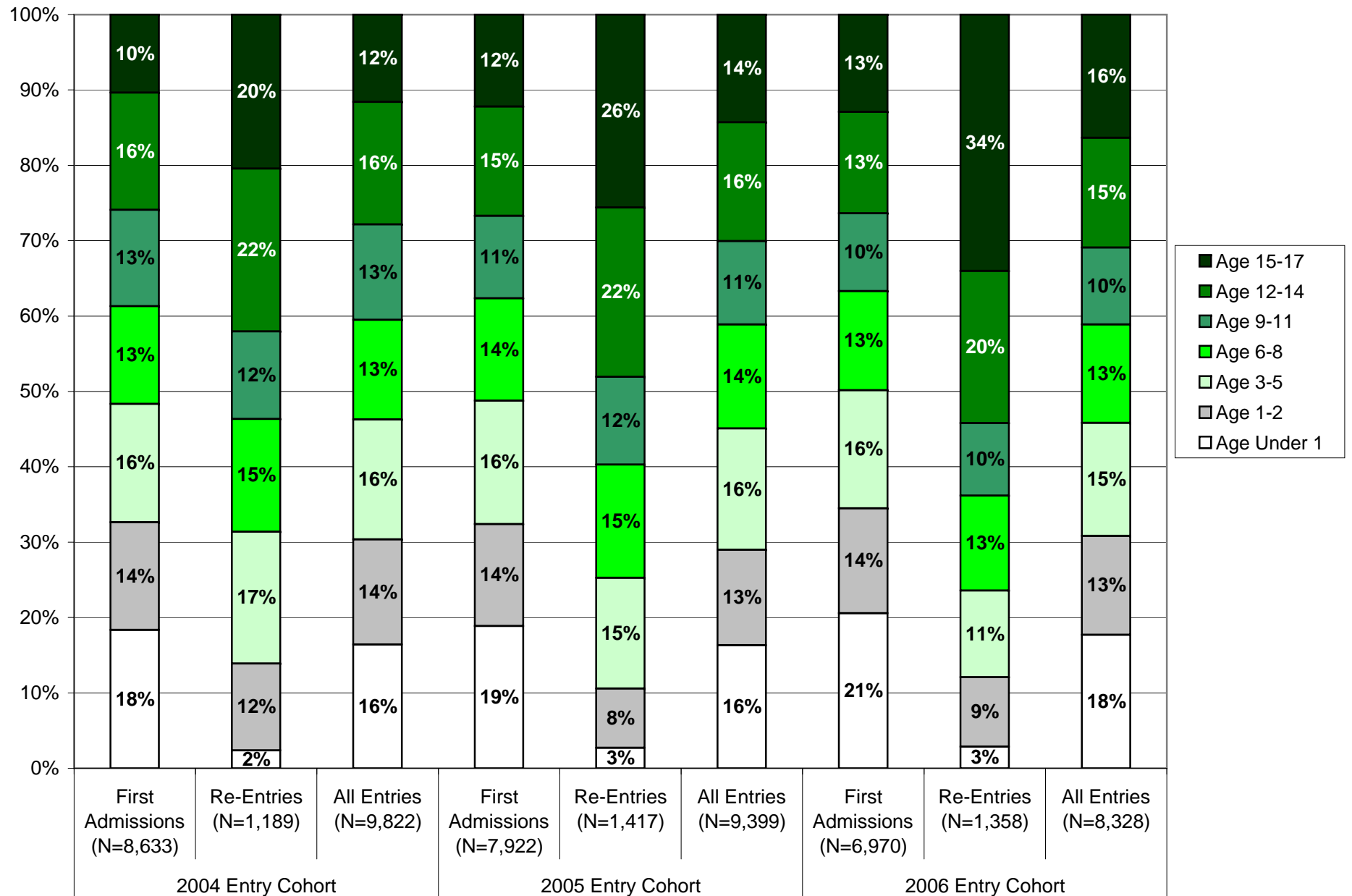
First Admissions & Re-Entries by Entry Cohort & Age Group State

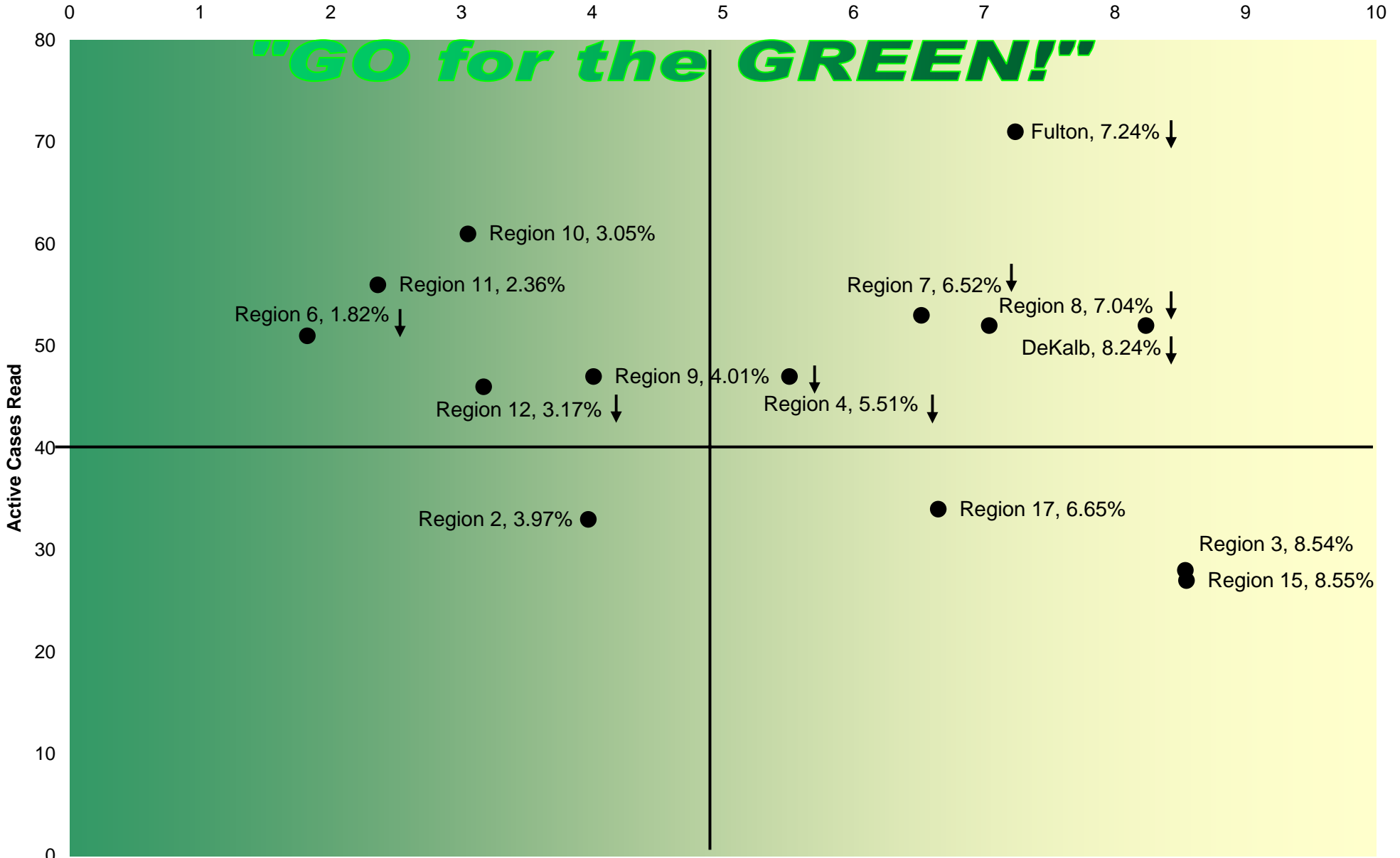

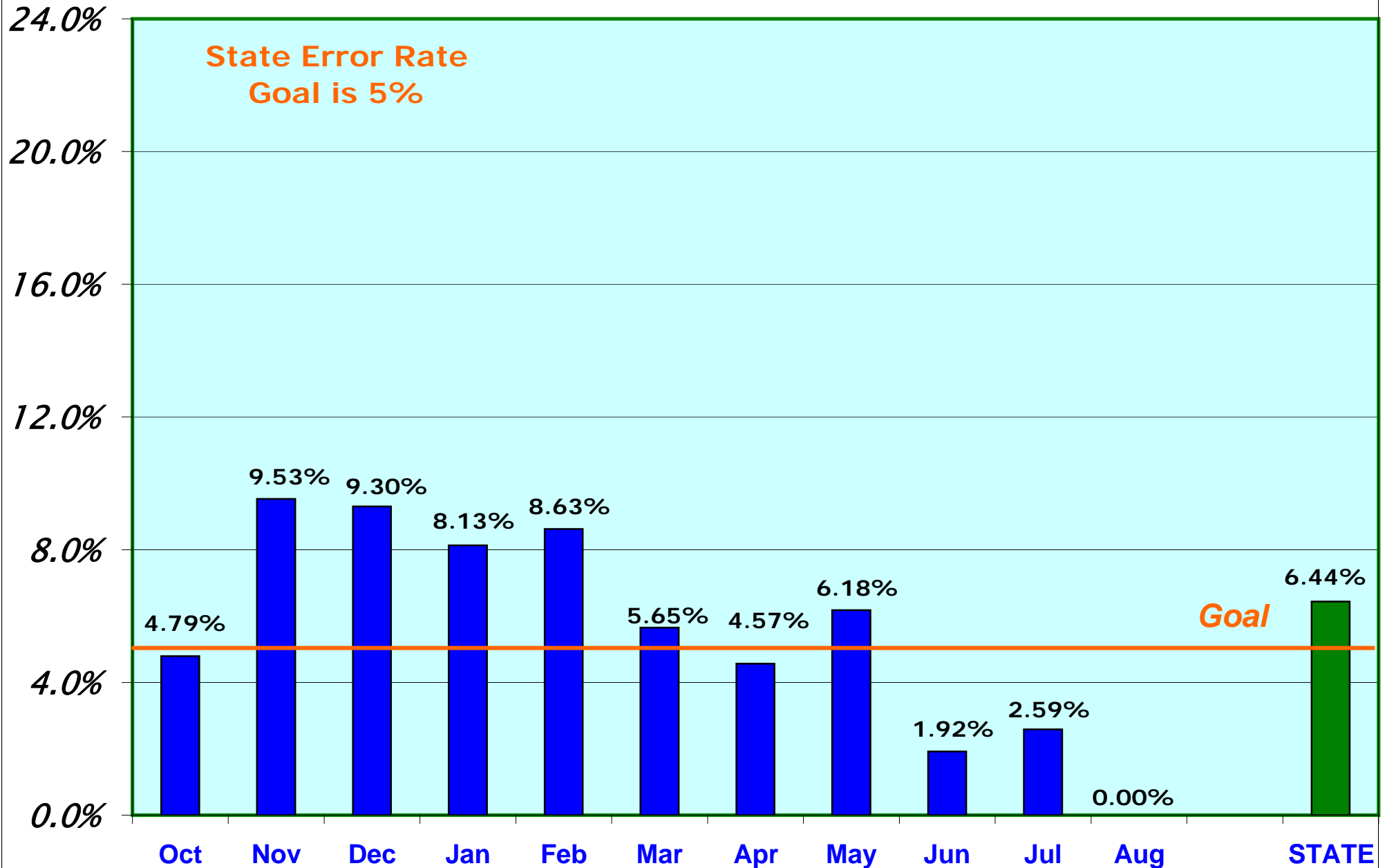
Allotment Error Rate (%)

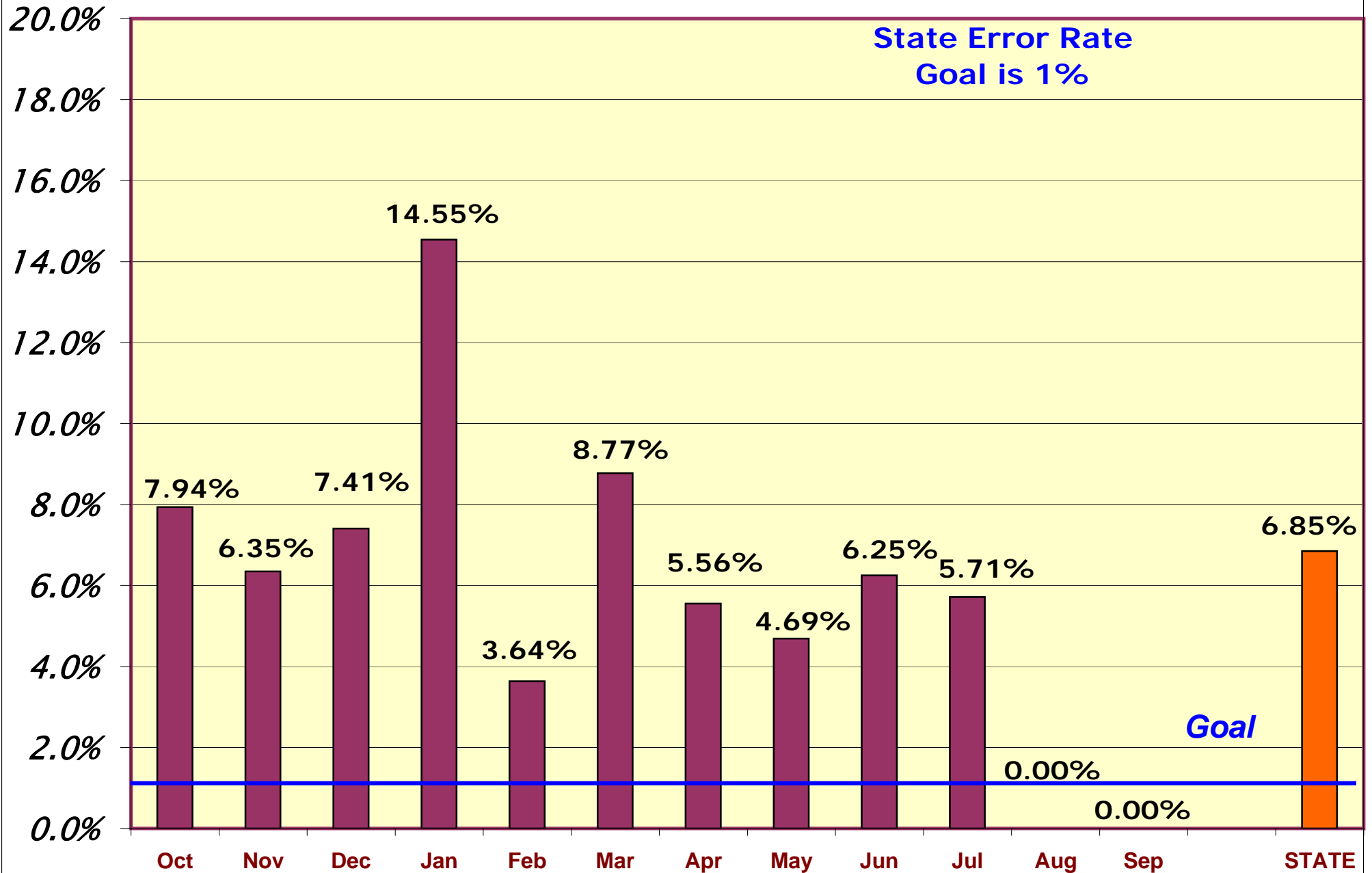

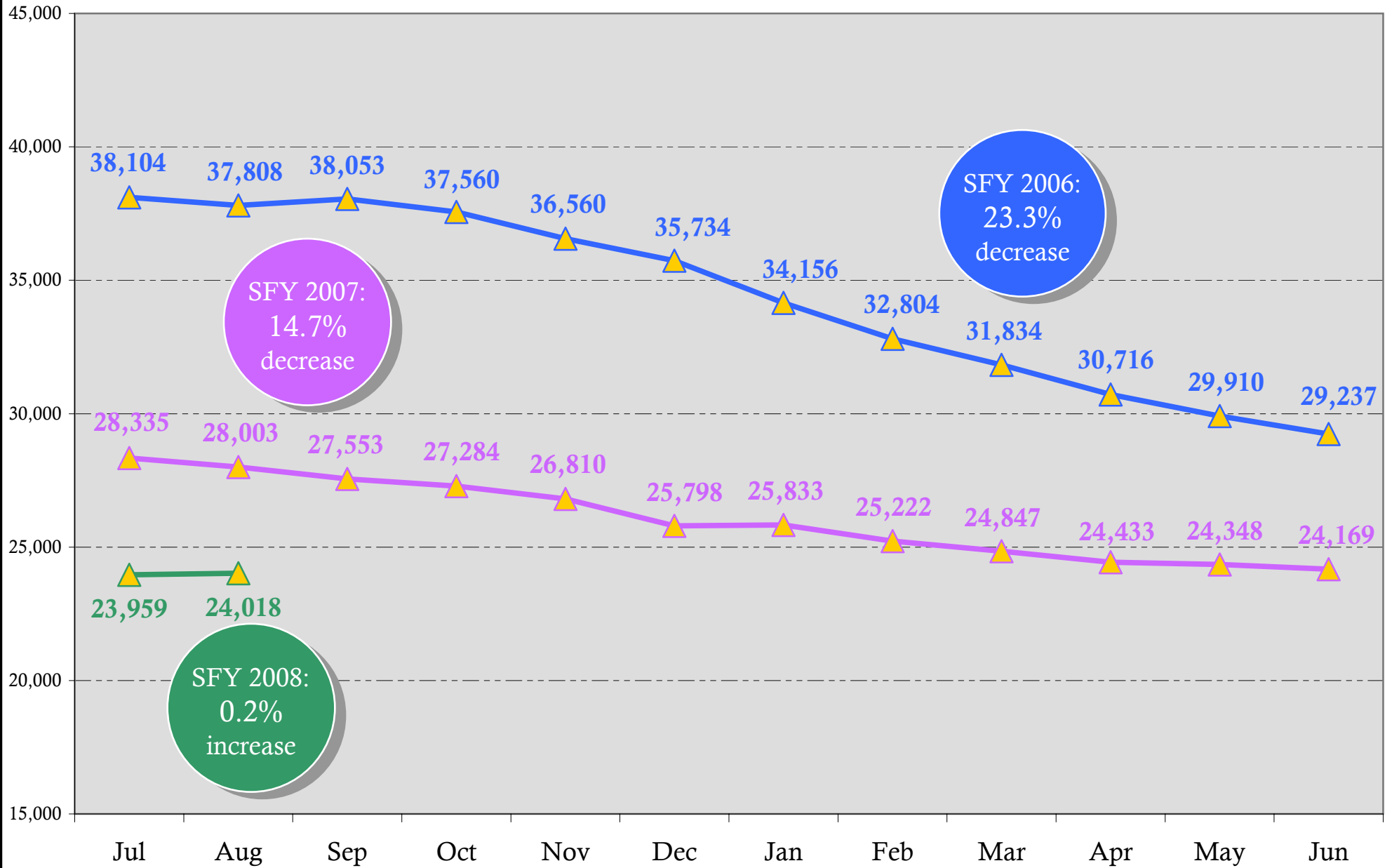

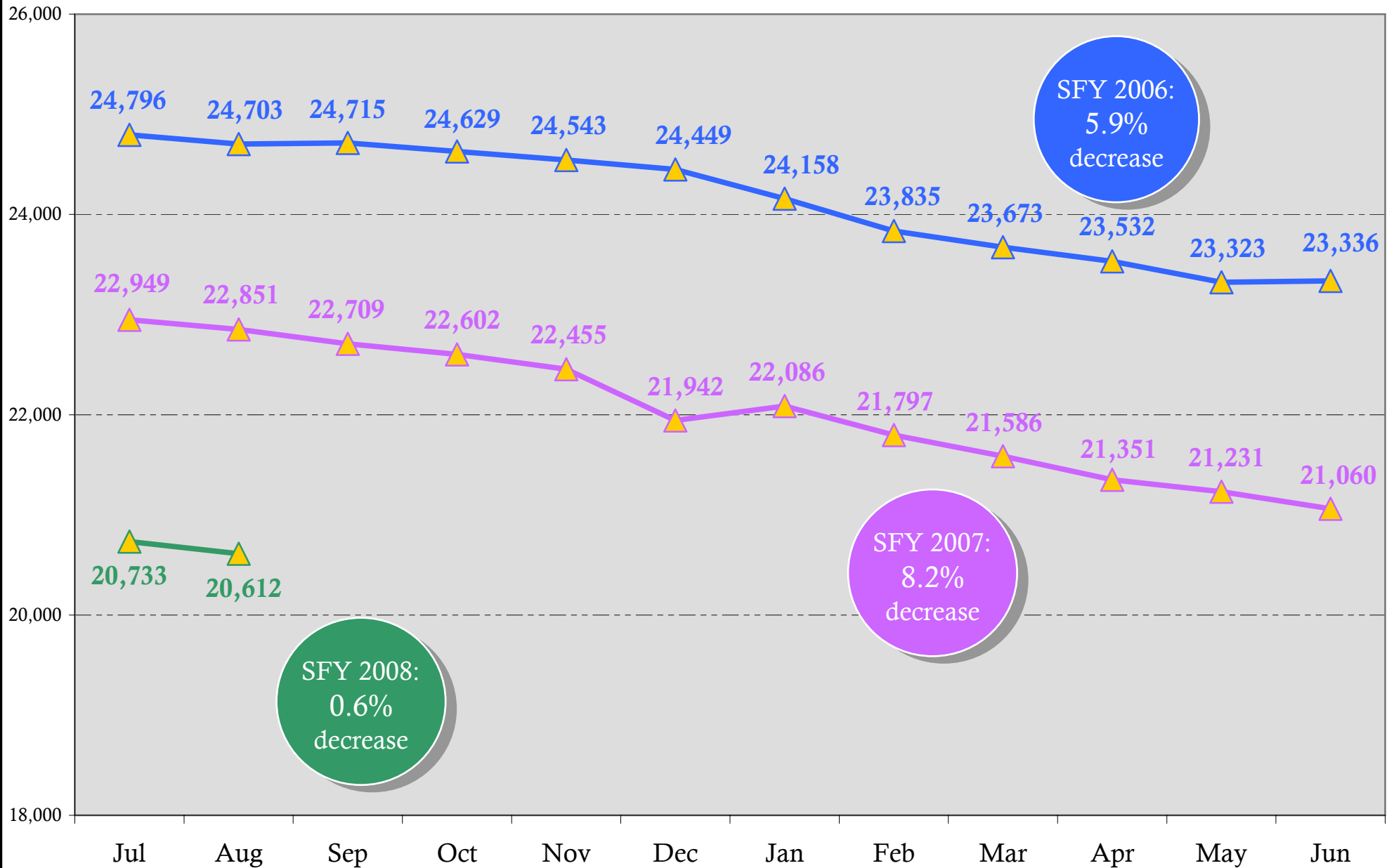
Number of Cases and Percent of State Caseload by Region August 2007

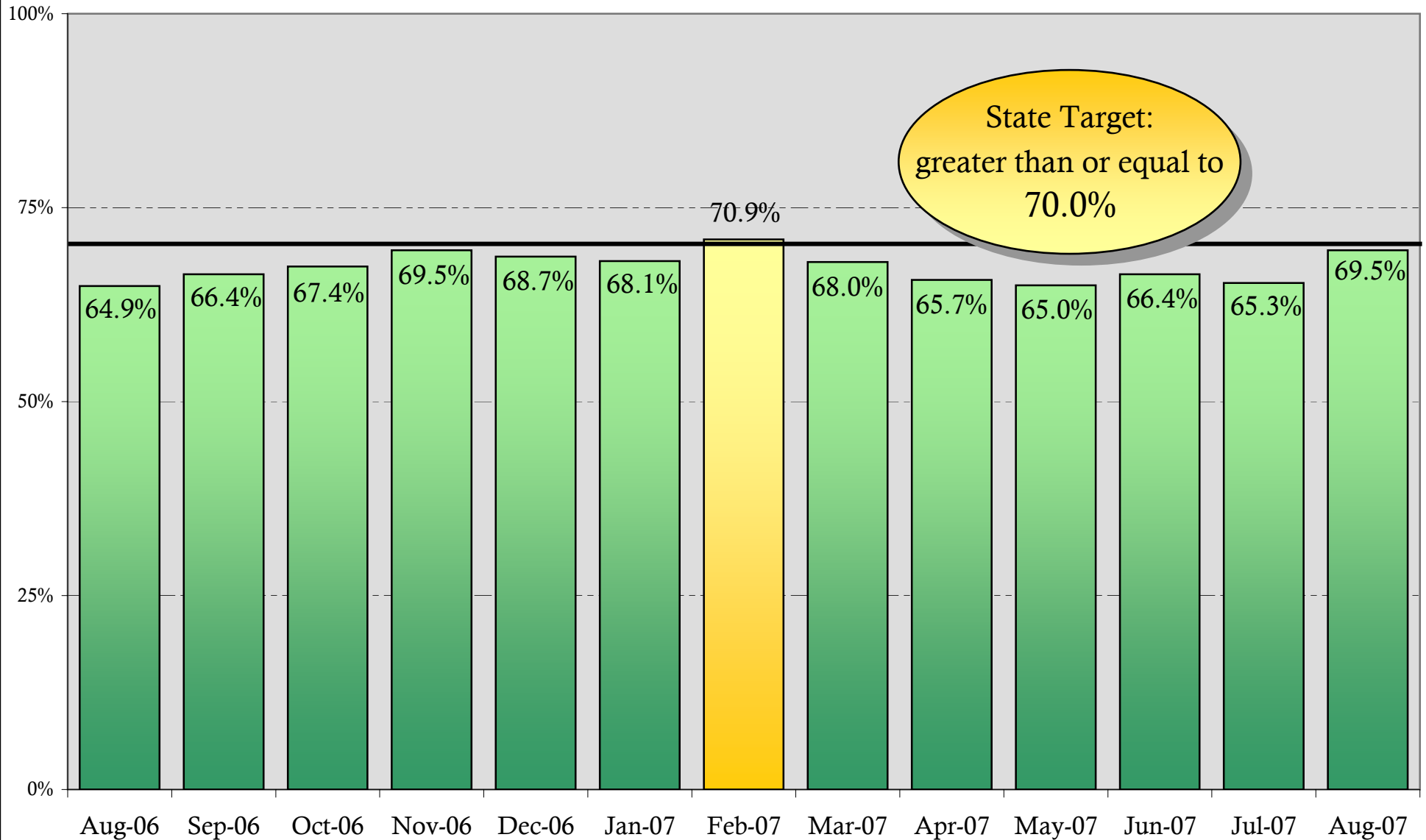

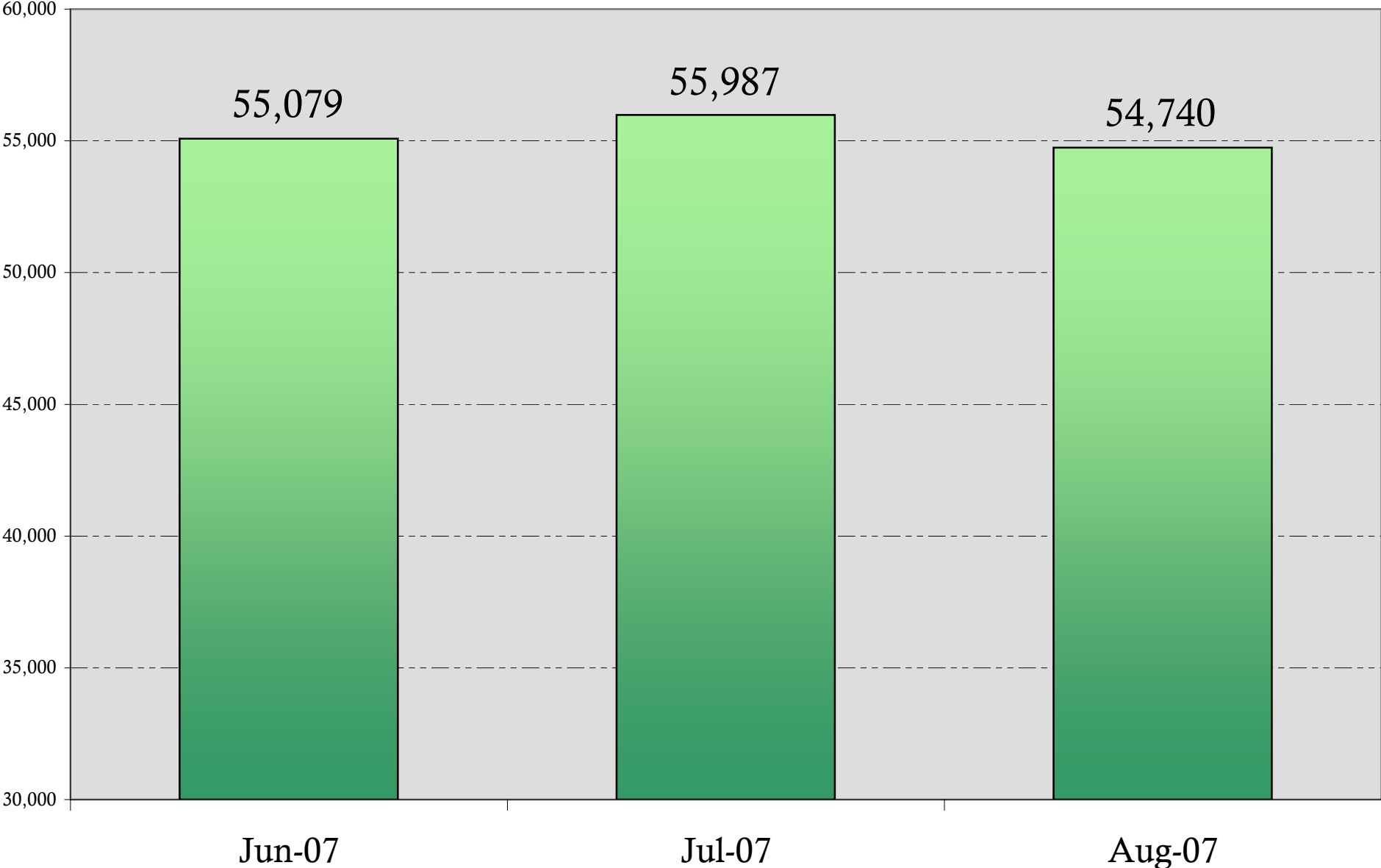


Regional Work Participation Rates August 2007



Number of Children in Childcare - Three Month View

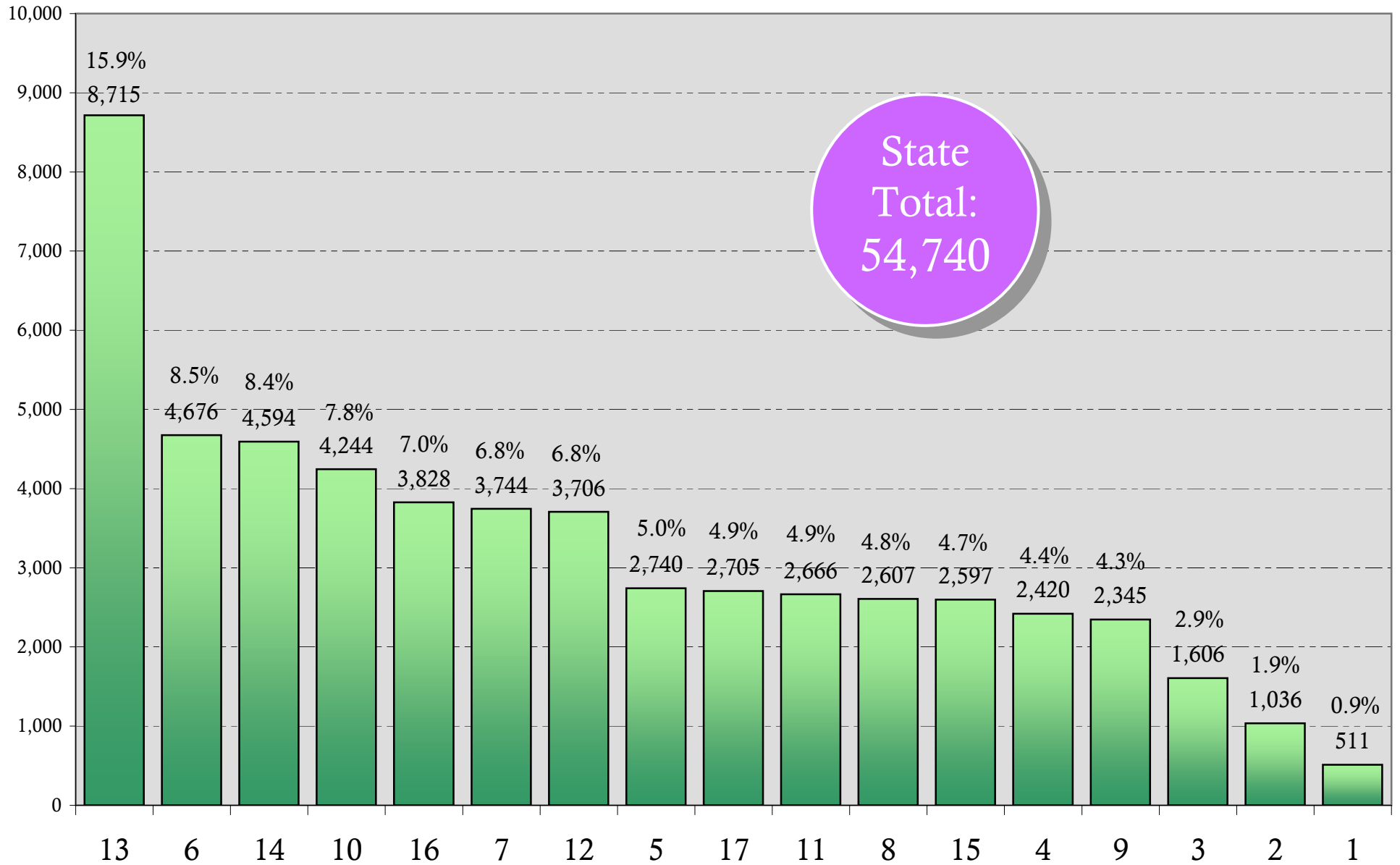
