SAFETY OUTCOME 1

Children are First and Foremost, Protected From Abuse and Neglect

ITEMS ASSESSED

- Timeliness of Investigations
(Strength in 76% of cases)
- Repeat Maltreatment
(Strength in 91% of Cases)

SAFETY OUTCOME 2

**Children are Safely Maintained in Their Homes
Whenever Possible and Appropriate**

ITEMS ASSESSED

- Services to Families to Protect Children in the Home and Prevent Removal
(Strength in 71% of Cases)
- Risk Assessment and Safety Management
(Strength in 67% of Cases)

PERMANENCY OUTCOME 1

Children Have Permanency and Safety in Their Living Situations

ITEMS ASSESSED

- Foster Care Re-entries
(Strength in 100% of Cases)
- Stability of Foster Care Placement
(Strength in 82% of Cases)
- Permanency Goal for the Child
(Strength in 60% of Cases)

(Strength in 68% of Cases)
 - Adoption
(Strength in 36% of Cases)
 - Other Planned Permanent Living Arrangement
(Strength in 43% of Cases)
