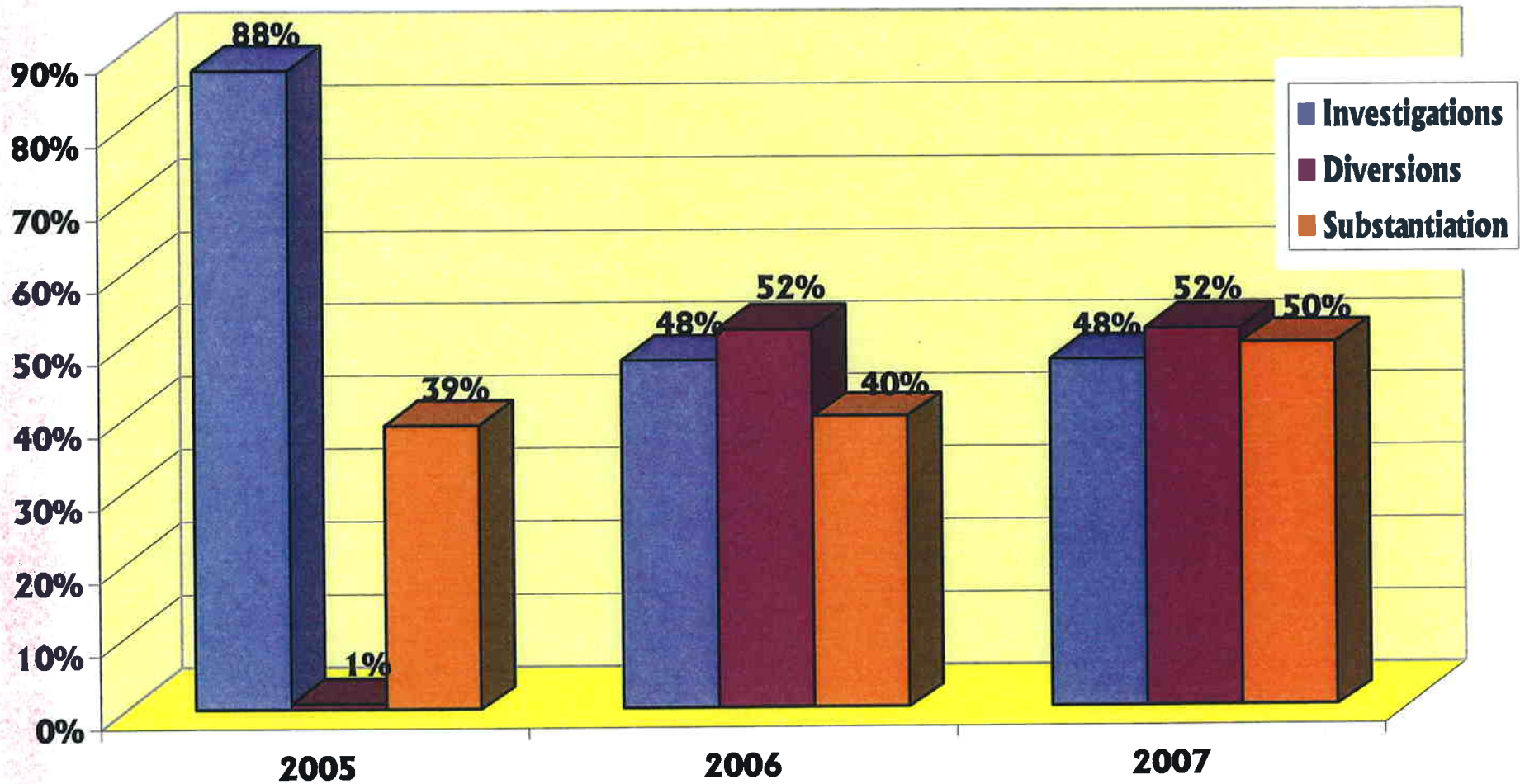
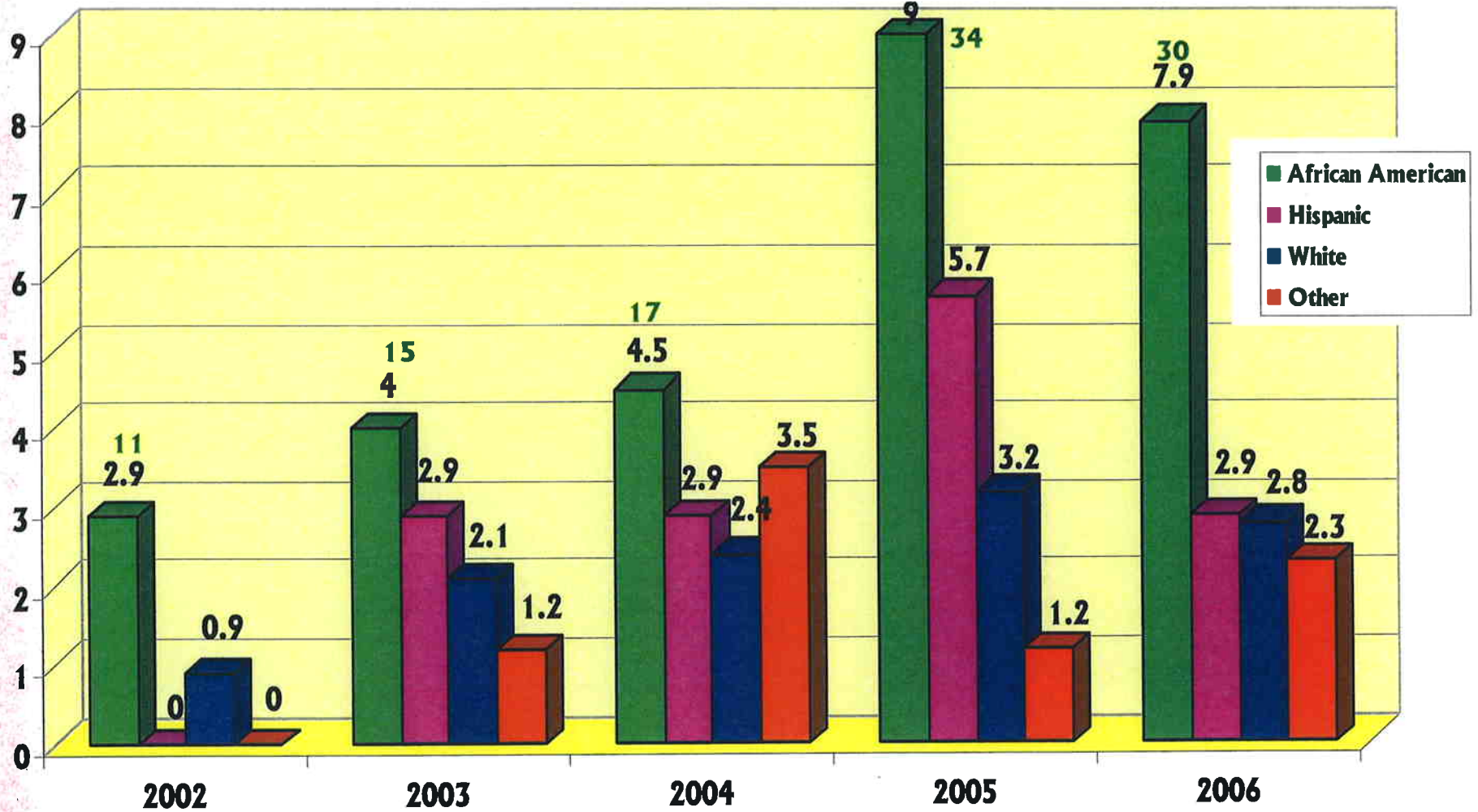


FAYETTE COUNTY TREND FOR AFRICAN AMERICANS FROM 2005 - 2007



- The percent of investigations decreased from 88% to 48% in 2006 and 2007 while the diversions rose to 52% and remained constant for both years also.
- Substantiation rates have increased as staff are more effective at determining which cases should be investigated rather than diverted.

•African American children have highest first entry rates per thousand. The number in green represents the actual number of African American children who entered care during that year.

•African-American children have not had a second entry (re-entry) into foster care in Fayette County during the years indicated above.
