CFSR Outcomes and Indicators

Safety Outcome 1: Children are, first and foremost, protected from abuse and neglect.

Item 1. Timeliness of initiating investigations **95%** - 30 day

Safety Outcome 2: Children are safely maintained in their own homes whenever possible and appropriate.
