








#### Recurrence of Substantiated Child Maltreatment (December 2011 – December 2012)



#### Disposition of Child Abuse and Neglect Reports (December 2012)










#### Number of Children in the Legal Custody of DFCS (December 2012)




#### Children in the Legal Custody of DFCS Under the Age of 18 (December 2011 - December 2012)




#### Length of Time to Reunification (December 2011 - December 2012)


Def: Percentage of children who exited care during the month through reunification with their family that reunified in less than 12 months from the date of their last removal.



#### Comparison of Foster Care Entries and Exits (December 2011 - December 2012)




#### Foster Care Re-Entry Rate (December 2011 - December 2012)
