New Reports Available

- A New Report has been added to the Electronic Reporting Website (ebill2.gagta.com) to allow providers to better manage encounter tracking.
 - Accepted Encounters Received to Date (HRMH1PASER)

Note: This report is produced weekly each Friday and includes encounters received to date. Each time it is produced, it will include encounters that have been received since the beginning of the report period.

Consumers w/o SSN's

On 3/15/2008 there will be a new procedure for assigning a CID to consumers with no SSN.

Providers will be required to generate CID's for consumers without SSN's prior to entering a MICP for that consumer.

System Enhancements (7/1/2008)

Service Packages:

- The MICP system will be modified to allow specific "packages" of services to be requested:
 - Brief Registration
 - Crisis Stabilization
 - Med Maintenance
 - Intensive Outpatient
- Batch providers will submit a service package code to request an authorization for all services in the package.

System Enhancements (7/1/2008)

Service Groups:

- This change is only applicable to providers submitting MICPs via batch transmission.
 - When submitting a MICP via batch, providers will use new service group codes to identify individual services.
 - Due to the expansion of the HIPAA service codes, this will allow providers to submit the service group code and be authorized for all HIPAA codes for that service.

New Services

There will be some new services effective 7/1/2008:

1. Community Transitional Planning
2. Residential Services:
 - a) Independent Residential Service
 - b) Semi-Independent Residential Service
 - c) Intensive Residential Service
 - d) Family Treatment Homes

Look for future communications and service definitions for these new services.

Additional Service Codes

On 7/1/2008 there will be new service codes added to the following services:

1. CSP Transitional Beds
 - H0018 U2 TB
 - H0018 HA U2 TB
2. TAPP (Case Mgt for High Risk Populations)
 - T2016 TK UK (Collateral Contacts)

These services will be authorized when selecting the current CSP or TAPP service.

New Data Elements

1. Lawful Presence – identifies whether the individual is lawfully present in the United States.

New Field Edits

On 7/1/2008 there will be new field edits implemented into the MICP system:

Substances Used (None, Alcohol, Drugs, Both)

1. None – will not allow any of the sub-sections to be completed
2. Alcohol – will only allow primary sub-section to be completed
3. Drugs or Both – will allow primary, secondary and tertiary sub-sections to be completed.

Route of Administration: If Alcohol is substance used, route of administration must be oral.
