**Adolescent AD Group Homes** – will provide a structured temporary living situation for youth 13-17 years olds dealing with substance abuse related disorders. The average length of stay will be based on the needs of the youth but it is anticipated to be 6 months. Each group home will have an outpatient AD treatment component as ASAM level 2.1-2.5 provided by an outside agency. Treatment services will be gender specific, individualized and based on the adolescent's individualized resiliency plan.
